

PROJECT REQUIREMENTS FOR MARKET ANIMALS

- Own and practice good husbandry practices in feeding, managing and caring for your animal.
- Participate in the county uniform feeding program.
- Attend six meetings.
- Give a demonstration or illustrated talk.
- Complete the 4-H record book including a story.
- Participate in the fitting and showing contest.
- Exhibit project animal and completed record book at fair.
- Follow all food and drug regulations on use of animal's health and feed products including labeled withdrawal periods.
- Participation in the 4-H program is a privilege not a right. Inappropriate behavior or language, abuse of animals or disrespect of others will not be tolerated and are grounds for dismissal.

4-H/FFA MARKET LIVESTOCK SALE REQUIREMENTS

- Member must complete 4-H or FFA project requirements
- Animal must meet market quality (only blue or red ribbon animals will sell, NO white ribbon animals will sell).
- Animal must weigh a minimum of:
 - 100 pounds for lambs
 - 200 pounds for swine
 - 1000 pounds for beef
